Injuries caused by water jet



- 1. Keep injured body area raised.
- 2. Cover wound with a sterile dressing.
 Use a pressure dressing if bleeding is extensive.
- 3. Observe the condition of the injured person closely.
- 4. Amputated body parts should be placed in a sterile bag and kept as cool as possible.
- 5. Arrange professional medical attention immediately.
